Results of Recent ACCI Survey

Enclosed you will find the results of our most recent "What Do CEOs Want to Know About?" survey on leadership transitions. The data reported here point to an interesting time of transition in the years ahead.

Our survey revealed that in the next three years more than 25 percent of the CEOs surveyed will retire. In the next five years, almost 40 percent of these CEOs will retire. We are clearly facing major leadership transitions in the community college field. Indeed, the CEOs surveyed called for continued and expanded leadership training for the next generation of community college presidents.
